LOW-FOAMING DETERGENT FOR AUTOMATIC WASHERS

DIRECTIONS

Master MHW emulsifies dirt, oils and organic material, leaving surfaces spotless. Pre-cleaning with Master MHW is an ideal step prior to disinfection.

Master MHW is designed to work without producing excessive foam in high-agitation environments such as spray nozzles, scrubbers, high-speed stirrers and pumps.

Master MHW will not harm concrete, plastic, poly, rubber, glass, paintwork, stainless steel, iron or soft metals such as aluminum when used as directed.

APPLICATION METHODS

Pre-dissolve Master MHW at the rate of 1 to 2 oz per gallon of water. Use hot or warm water if available.

Horticultural Applications

Master MHW's low-foaming characteristics make it ideal removing deposits from plastic and styro-foam plug trays and pots using automated washing equipment.

Areas of Use: all automatic washing equipment for plastic items such as pots, plug trays and pails, particularly those employing high-pressure spray nozzles.

Prevention:

Keep only in original packaging.

Responses:
